Background

REACH's Mission: *To inspire citizen engagement and coordinated agency action to strengthen and sustain community safety in Edmonton.*

REACH is Edmonton's Council for Safe Communities that acts as a backbone organization striving for collective impact. They support and bring together organizations, community groups and Edmontonians to co-develop solutions to make Edmonton a safer city for everyone.

REACH conducts its work through community involvement, stakeholder engagement, and inter-agency collaboration to:

- Heighten the efficiency of current social programs and funding streams to better integrate programs.
- Find and fill any service gaps in the current system.
- Engage citizens in developing solutions.

The Board of Directors is responsible for the governance of REACH Edmonton. As a member of the Board, a Director's role is to guide the strategic direction of the organization in making Edmonton safer for everyone.

REACH Edmonton is accountable to the City of Edmonton, funders and stakeholders. The Board of Directors provides oversight and is responsible for REACH Edmonton's performance in achieving its goals, and for effective financial management of the organization.
