

Background

Options to Deter Catalytic Converter Theft

- 1. That Community and Public Services Committee recommend to City Council:
 - That the Mayor, on behalf of City Council and with input from the Edmonton Police Commission, write letters to the Government of Canada and the Government of Alberta.
- That EPS explore voluntary etching programs with local Mechanics and Dealerships.
- 3. City Administration exploring the addition of operating requirements to Business Licence Bylaw 20002 as part of an upcoming review of its strategic partnership with EPS.
