

Background

Two motions directing Administration to:

- Prepare amendments to Vehicle for Hire Bylaw 17400 to expand accessibility driver training requirements to all Vehicle for Hire Drivers (March 2022)
- Add provisions clarifying that vehicle for hire drivers may request a deposit from a passenger before providing service, and may refuse service if one is not provided (May 2023)



UPE01189rev: Expand accessibility driver training requirements to all Vehicle for Hire drivers
