Recommendations

- 1. That the agreements between the City of Edmonton and EPCOR Utilities Inc. (or an affiliate) for the design, build, financing, operation and maintenance of the Downtown District Energy System, be approved, and that the agreements be in form and content acceptable to the City Manager.
