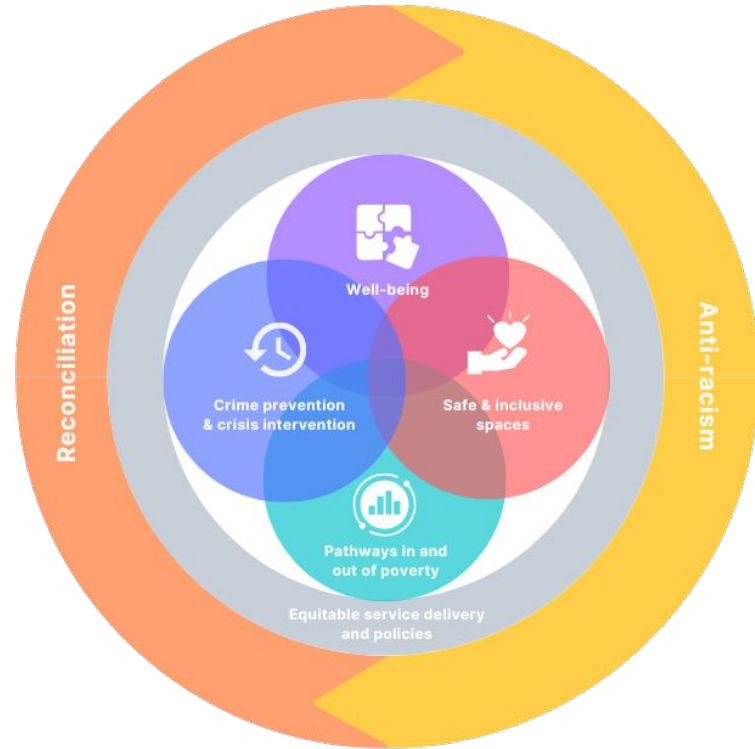

CSWB Strategy Vision

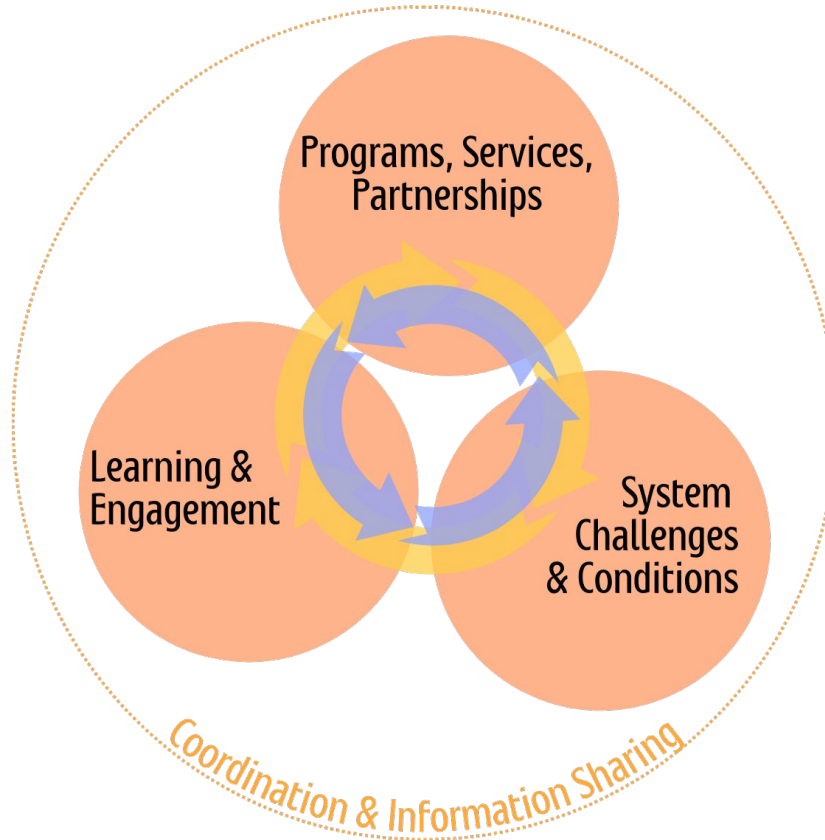
- Purpose, safety, stability for all who make Edmonton home

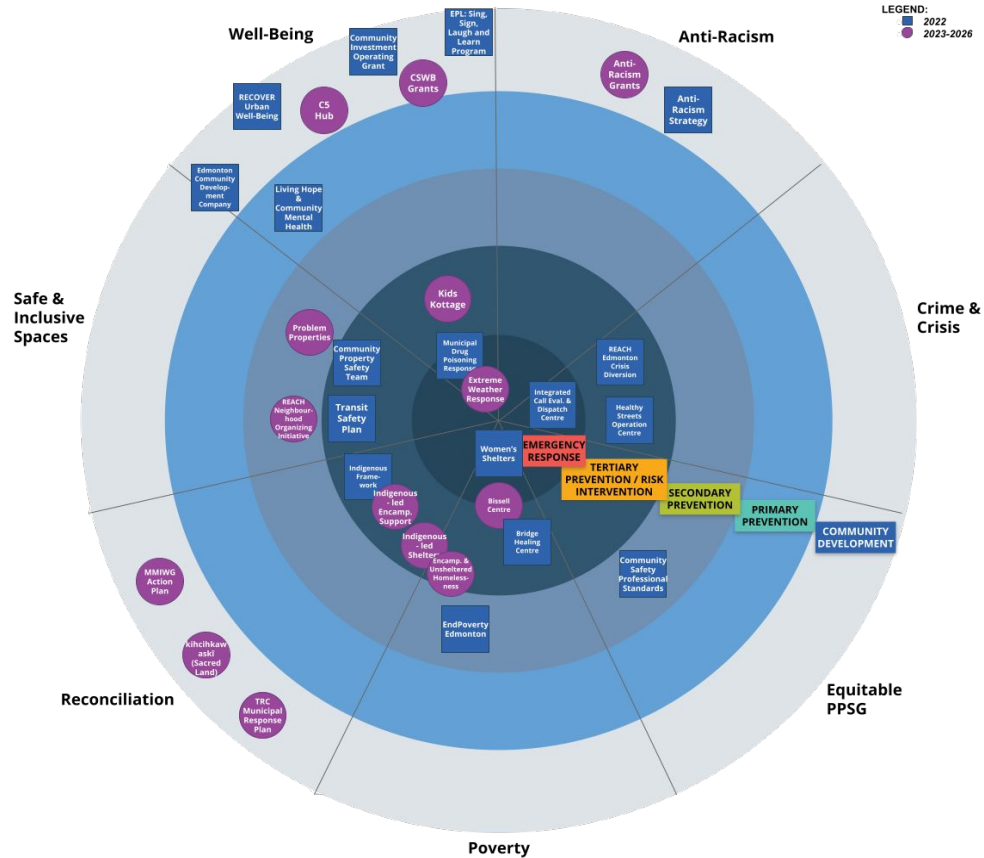

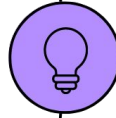
