#### **Overview**

- The City is seeking a five-year extension to an existing sole source agreement with EPCOR Distribution & Transmission (D&T) for LRT substation monitoring and control services.
- EPCOR D&T provides continuous, round-the-clock monitoring and remote control of the LRT substations.
- These services have historically been provided through the EPCOR Technologies agreement that has lapsed since the closure of EPCOR's Technologies division.



#### **EPCOR D&T Substation Monitoring and Control**

- EPCOR D&T has a control centre that monitors all of the electrical substations in the City, including the 17 owned by ETS.
- The Service to the ETS Substations include:
  - 24/7 monitoring
  - Communicate with City staff to rectify issues
  - Remotely switch on/off circuits
  - Record/store data log including events/alarms
- This type of function is common across all electrified train systems to maintain reliability and system up-time.
