Background

- → April 10, 2018: City Council approved expanding fare-free transit for children age five and under to age 12 and under, provided they travel with a fare-paying rider
- → October 26, 2022 Community and Public Services Committee Administration presented analysis on removing the accompaniment requirement
 - Consistency within the region
 - Demand shifting from yellow bus to ETS, and capacity impacts
 - ◆ Fare revenue impacts
- → Motion to return with the amendment to the Fare Policy



Considerations

- → Financial implications:
 - Approximately 1,250 passes are sold monthly to students 12 and under
 - ◆ Equals a minimum of \$900,000 in fare revenue
 - Unable to estimate other fare revenue loss from youth purchasing fare outside of schools and adults paying to accompany children
- → Should Committee wish to proceed, a service package would need to be funded through the Fall 2023 Supplemental Operating Budget Adjustment
- → Policy approval would follow at a subsequent Council meeting
