- 2. That remaining 2023 CSWB funding of \$4,313,000 be returned to Financial Strategies and remain unallocated in order to generate

surplus 2023 budget to partially offset the City of Edmonton projected 2023 tax-supported operating budget deficit. One-time Anti-Racism Strategy funding of \$350,000 will remain in the City Manager's Office.
