**COMMUNITY SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD BYLAW**

Edmonton City Council enacts:

**PART I - INTERPRETATION**

<b>PURPOSE</b>	1	The purpose of this bylaw is to establish the Community Services Advisory Board as a council committee, and to establish its membership and mandate.
<b>DEFINITIONS</b>	2	<p>(1) Unless otherwise specified, words used in this bylaw have the same meaning as defined in the <i>Municipal Government Act</i>, RSA 2000, c M-26.</p> <p>(2) In this bylaw:</p> <p>(a) “<b>City</b>” means The City of Edmonton;</p> <p>(b) “<b>City Manager</b>” means the chief administrative officer of the City or delegate; and</p> <p>(c) “<b>Council</b>” means the City’s council.</p>
<b>RULES FOR INTERPRETATION</b>	3	The marginal notes and headings in this bylaw are for ease of reference only.

**PART II - MANDATE**

<b>MANDATE</b>	4	The mandate of the Community Services Advisory Board will be to provide advice regarding grant funding allocations and to have a key role in developing a long term plan for community services in the City.
<b>FUNCTIONS &amp; AUTHORITIES</b>	5	<p>To carry out its mandate, Community Services Advisory Board may:</p> <p>(a) raise issues and provide advice, from a resident perspective, related to the priorities within the Community Services department’s mandate;</p> <p>(b) make recommendations to the City Manager about the</p>

allocation of funds provided to the City under the *Family and Community Support Services Act*, RSA 2000, c F-3;

- (c) make recommendations to Council and the City Manager for applicable grants and awards as required; and
- (d) gather information and share knowledge.

### **PART III - MEMBERSHIP**

The Community Services Advisory Board will be comprised of up to 13 members appointed by Council.

#### **PART IV - TRANSITION & REPEAL**

<b>TRANSITION</b>	7	On the coming into force of this bylaw, members appointed to the Community Services Advisory Board will continue to be members until the expiry of their current term.
<b>REPEAL</b>	8	The Community Services Advisory Board Bylaw, Bylaw 11926, is repealed.
