PART I - INTERPRETATION

| PURPOSE | 1 | The purpose of this bylaw is to establish the Community Services Advisory Board as a council committee, and to establish its membership and mandate. |

PART II - MANDATE

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| MANDATE | 4 | The mandate of the Community Services Advisory Board will be to provide advice regarding grant funding allocations and to have a key role in developing a long term plan for community services in the City. |
| FUNCTIONS & AUTHORITIES | 5 | <p>To carry out its mandate, Community Services Advisory Board may:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(a) raise issues and provide advice, from a resident perspective, related to the priorities within the Community Services department’s mandate;</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(b) make recommendations to the City Manager about the</p> |

allocation of funds provided to the City under the *Family and Community Support Services Act*, RSA 2000, c F-3;

- (c) make recommendations to Council and the City Manager for applicable grants and awards as required; and
- (d) gather information and share knowledge.

PART III - MEMBERSHIP

MEMBERSHIP

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The Community Services Advisory Board will be comprised of up to 13 members appointed by Council.

PART IV - TRANSITION & REPEAL

TRANSITION	7	On the coming into force of this bylaw, members appointed to the Community Services Advisory Board will continue to be members until the expiry of their current term.
REPEAL	8	The Community Services Advisory Board Bylaw, Bylaw 11926, is repealed.
