Background

- Utility account holders pay the waste utility rate that matches their collection service
- → When ratepayers transfer to curbside collection from apartment and condo collection, transitional waste utility rates are used to minimize rate shock

Service Transition Rates

- → A permanent, five-year transitional waste utility rate schedule would be included in Waste Services Bylaw 20363
- → Service Transition Rates provide transparent rate information to current and future transitional rate customers
