Road Right-of-Way Obstruction Permit and Enforcement Data


On-Street Construction and Maintenance permits are issued for construction and maintenance work on road right-of-way, including streets and sidewalks.

The introduction of a \$25 per day fee in February 2019 resulted in fewer obstruction permits being issued, and for shorter durations.

The number of permits issued per year has remained relatively stable from 2019 to 2022, aside from an increase seen in 2021. This may be related to increased construction activity in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic.

On-Street Construction and Maintenance Permits Issued


