To allow for the development of a stormwater management facility. The A and AP Zones will allow for the protection of and preservation of natural areas and public park uses, Edgemont

Purpose

Rezoning from AG to the RLD, PU, A and AP located at 2367 and 2703 WInterburn Road.

When Zoning Bylaw 20001 becomes effective January 1, 2024, the RLD, PU, A and AP zones will become the RSF, PU, A and PSN zones.

Readings

Charter Bylaw 20667 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree that Charter Bylaw 20667 be considered for third reading.

Advertising and Signing

This Charter Bylaw was advertised in the Edmonton Journal on November 24, 2023, and December 2, 2023. The Charter Bylaw can be passed following third reading.
