### Municipal Benchmarking

Administration compared Edmonton’s 2022 cost per hectare for Turf and Horticulture maintenance to other Western Canadian municipalities using data from Yardstick, a private benchmarking tool that allows organizations to compare various performance data. This data is categorized for operations and maintenance expenditures on:

- Verges turf maintenance: all types of mown and maintained grass, including parks and school fields
- Grass sports field maintenance: grass or turf on outdoor sports fields
- Shrub bed maintenance: all planted beds in parks, public green spaces and streets
