Pop-up Dog Parks

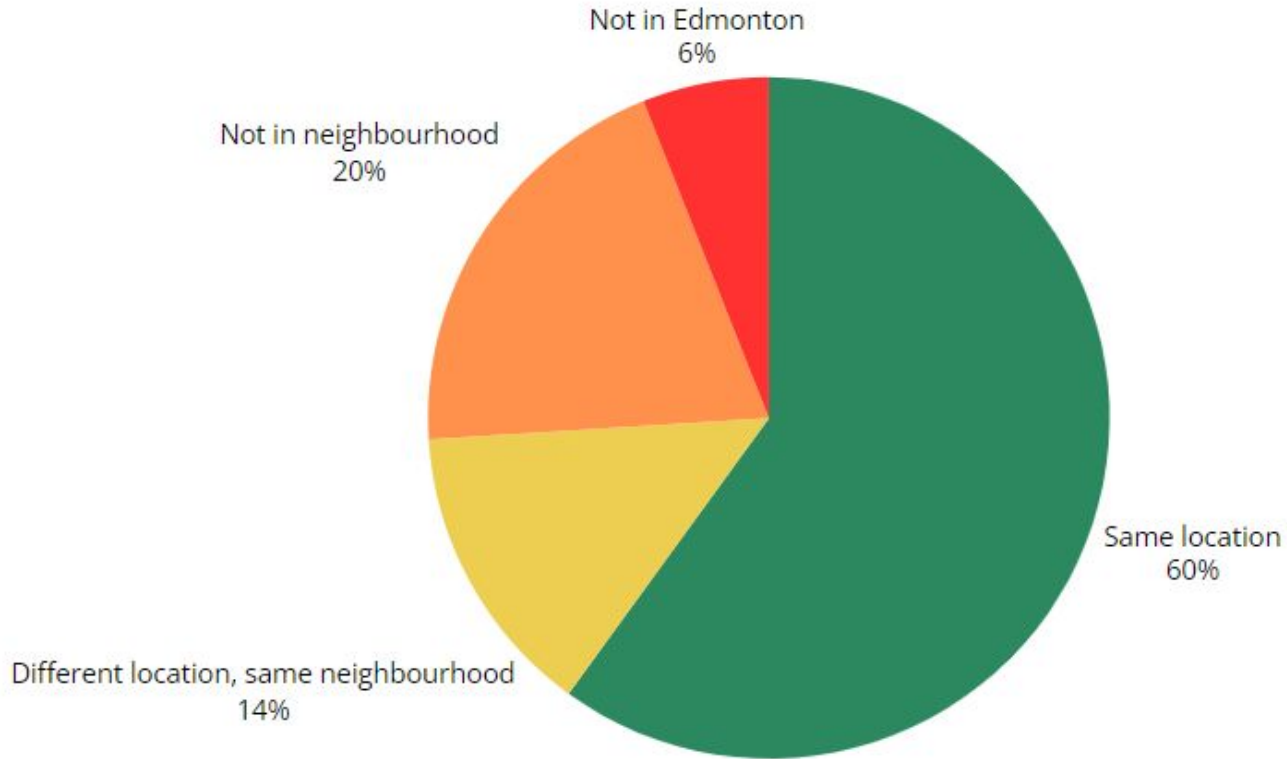
- 19 temporary off-leash areas

- Sites selected through public engagement

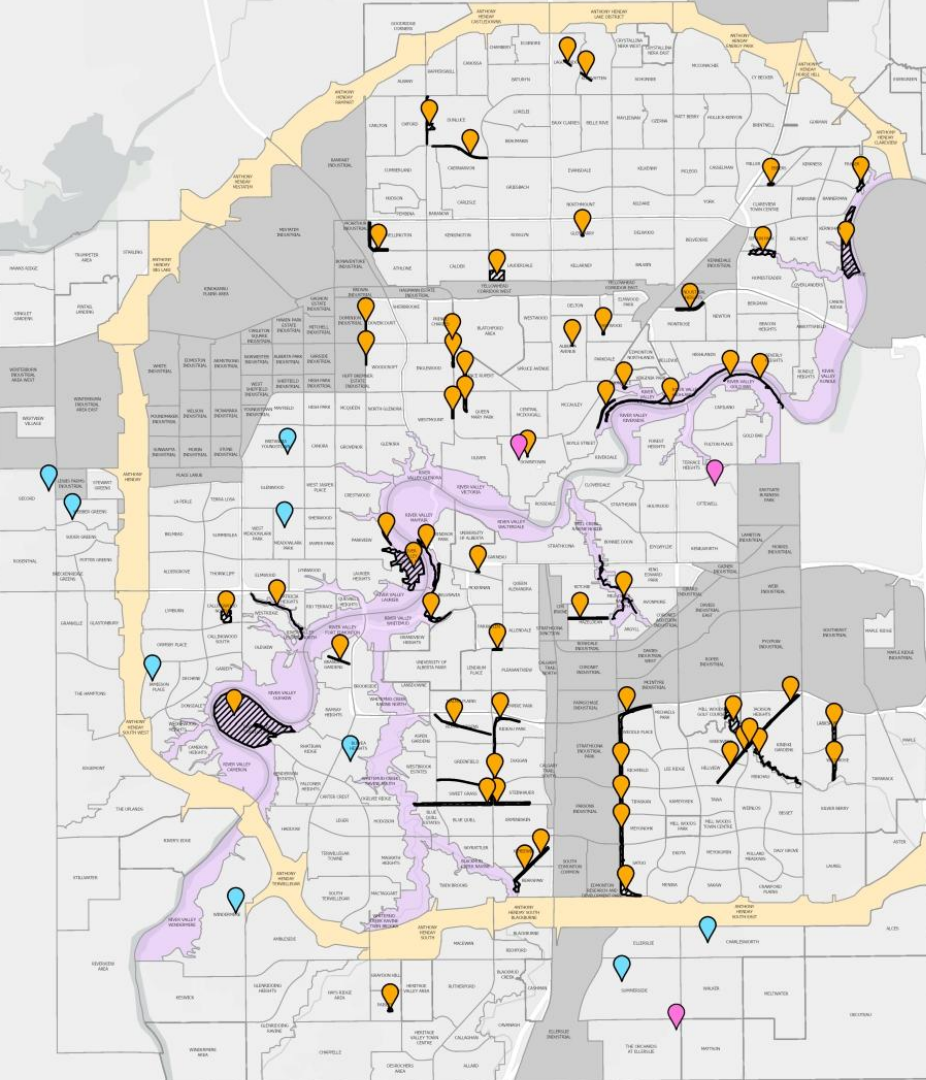


Off-Leash Area Locations

- City-led
 - ◆ Pleasantview
 - ◆ Future sites in Ottewell and Warehouse Park
- Developer-led
 - ◆ The Orchards Dog Park - 2024
- Community-led
 - ◆ 7 Community League Dog Parks
 - ◆ Community Group Led Construction - no applications
