BYLAW 17685

A Bylaw to repeal Bylaw 16116, Waste Management Project, Processing Infrastructure & Facilities

WHEREAS:

The Council of the City of Edmonton July 4, 2012 duly passed Bylaw 16116, authorizing the City of Edmonton to undertake, construct and finance Waste Management Project, Processing Infrastructure & Facilities ("Project") and also authorizing the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer to borrow the sum of \$2,600,000.00 for a period of up to fifteen (15) years with the principal and interest to be repaid in semi-annual or annual instalments;

It has now been determined that the bylaw is no longer required;

THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONTON DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Bylaw 16116 be repealed.

2. This bylaw shall take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
