- Recruitment for Indigenous members to join WAVE





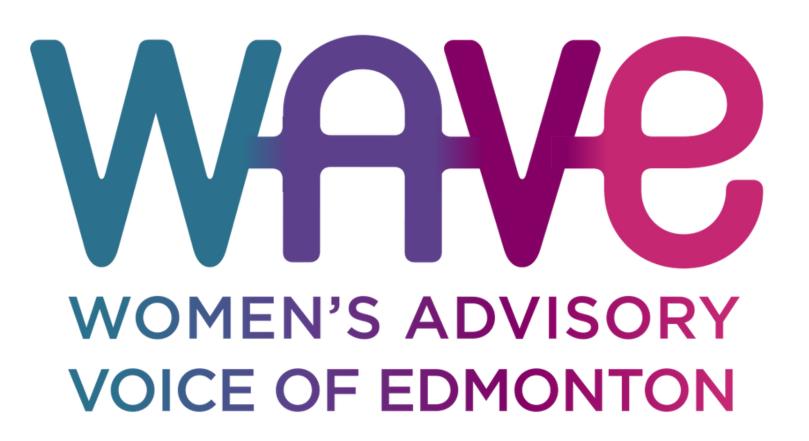
Work Plan 2024-2026
