BYLAW 17682

A Bylaw to repeal Bylaw 16722,
Sanitary Drainage Project -
Residuals Disposal Facility

WHEREAS:

The Council of the City of Edmonton on March 26, 2014 duly passed Bylaw 16722, authorizing the City of Edmonton to undertake, construct and finance Sanitary Drainage Project - Residuals Disposal Facility ("Project") and also authorizing the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer to borrow the sum of \$10,602,000.00 for a period of up to twenty-five (25) years with the principal and interest to be repaid in semi-annual or annual instalments;

It has now been determined that the bylaw is no longer required;

**THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONTON DULY ASSEMBLED
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Bylaw 16722 be repealed.

2. This bylaw shall take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
