Residential Parking Program Learnings

- Street parking for convenience, extra space, accessibility
- Non-parking concerns (speeding, crime, etc.)
- Jurisdictional scan
 - Fees, visitor parking
 - Traffic generators



Evolving the Residential Parking Program



- Aligned with Curbside Management Strategy
- Consistent program criteria and modernized delivery
- Data-driven approach and evaluation process
- Balanced between residents and visitors

New Program Framework

Traffic Generators

Program within 800m
or up to arterial road

Residential & Year Round

Hours aligned to current
EPark operations

Traffic generators include:

- Post- Secondary Institutions
 - *5,000+ Students*
- Major Event Venues
 - *10,000+ Attendees*
- LRT Stations with Transit Centres

Program Features

Fee Structure

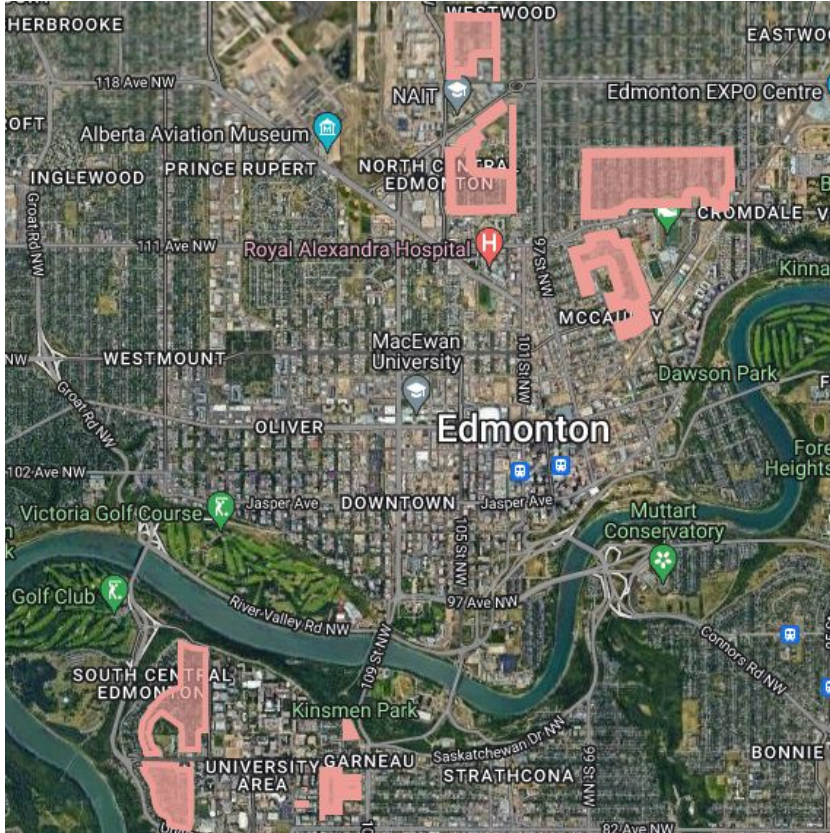
\$120 per permit

Multi-Residential Units

Eligible regardless of building size

- New fee structure in fall 2024
- Discounted student and low-income rates
- Digital permits
- Two-hour visitor parking

Next Steps



- Spring 2024
 - Resident/business communication
 - New digital permits
 - Remove discontinued program areas
 - Review alternate strategies where needed
- New program area applications in 2025
