COUNCIL REPORT – BYLAW



BYLAW 20069

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw 16642, as amended by Bylaws 17637, 17981 and 18476, to authorize the City of Edmonton to undertake, construct and finance Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, High Solids Anaerobics Digestion (HSAD) Facility

RECOMMENDATION

That Bylaw 20069 be given the appropriate readings.

Purpose

To amend Bylaw 16642 to increase the borrowing authority by \$530,000 from \$30,864,000 to \$31,394,000.

Readings

Bylaw 20069 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 20069 be considered for third reading."

Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw does not require advertising and the Bylaw can be signed and thereby passed following third reading.

Section 258(5) of the *Municipal Government Act* states that "the borrowing bylaw that authorizes the borrowing of the increased cost does not have to be advertised" if "the increased cost does not exceed 15% of the original cost of the capital property."

Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

Report Summary

This Bylaw amendment will increase the borrowing authority by \$530,000 from \$30,864,000 to \$31,394,000.

REPORT

The history of this borrowing bylaw is as follows:

- at the December 11, 2013 City Council meeting, Bylaw 16642 was passed;
- at the June 14, 2016 City Council meeting, Bylaw 17637, amending Bylaw 16642, was passed;
- at the May 9, 2017 City Council meeting, Bylaw 17981, amending Bylaw 16642, was passed;
- at the September 4, 2018 City Council meeting, Bylaw 18476, amending Bylaws 16642, was passed.

On August 16, 2021, Council approved an increase in borrowing of \$530,000 for profile 13-33-2023 High Solids Anaerobic Digestion (HSAD) Facility. The borrowing authority for this bylaw will therefore be increased by \$530,000 from \$30,864,000 to \$31,394,000.

The \$530,000 increase was transferred from capital profile CM-81-2045 Waste Services IIS Infrastructure Delivery. The increased borrowing authority on this bylaw is offset with a corresponding reduction in borrowing authority under Bylaw 20070 Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, Waste Services IIS Infrastructure Delivery (Financial and Corporate Services report FCS01142, Bylaw 20070 to amend Bylaw 18735, as amended by Bylaws 19248 and 19615, to authorize the City of Edmonton to undertake, construct and finance Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, Waste Services IIS Infrastructure Delivery), also being presented to City Council on April 19, 2022.

Bylaw 20069 will be accompanied by three readings of Bylaw 20070.

COMMUNITY INSIGHT

Borrowing bylaws reflect a legislative requirement of the borrowing process. As a result, no community insight is sought with respect to the borrowing bylaw process. Where required by the *Municipal Government Act*, borrowing bylaws are advertised.
