

BYLAW 20737

To authorize the City of Edmonton to undertake, construct and finance Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, 99 Street and Judy Padua Way Streetscape & Waterproofing

Recommendation

That Bylaw 20737 be given the appropriate readings.

Purpose

To authorize the City of Edmonton to borrow the sum of \$7.83 million to undertake, construct and finance Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, 99 Street and Judy Padua Way Streetscape & Waterproofing.

Readings

Bylaw 20737 is ready for second and third readings.

Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw was advertised in the Edmonton Journal on Friday, February 16, 2024, and Friday, February 23, 2024. The petition period expired March 11, 2024 and no sufficient petition was received. Upon second and third readings, this bylaw can be passed and signed.

In accordance with sections 251 and 258 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c. M-26, a long-term borrowing made for the purpose of financing a capital property for more than five years requires that the borrowing bylaw be advertised.

REPORT

The history of the borrowing bylaw is as follows:

- At the February 12, 2024, City Council meeting, Bylaw 20737, was read a first time.

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During the 2023 Fall Supplemental Capital Budget Adjustment deliberation from November 21, 2023 to November 29, 2023, Council approved a new standalone capital profile 23-12-9202 99 Street and Judy Padua Way Streetscape & Waterproofing within the 2023-2026 Capital Budget. The total project budget of \$16.27 million is funded with \$6.98 million of Local Government Fiscal Framework, \$1.18 million of Municipal Sustainability Initiative, \$285,589 of Pay-As-You-Go and \$7.83 million of Debt CRL Downtown.

The \$7.83 million of borrowing authority will be transferred from previously approved composite profiles as follows:

- \$402,175 of Debt CRL Downtown to be transferred from capital profile CM-50-5050 CRL Projects - Planning and Design to capital profile 23-12-9202 99 Street and Judy Padua Way Streetscape & Waterproofing.
- \$7.42 million of Debt CRL Downtown to be transferred from capital profile CM-74-4100 Downtown Community Revitalization Levies Delivery to capital profile 23-12-9202 99 Street and Judy Padua Way Streetscape & Waterproofing.

The corresponding amendments under Bylaw 20739 to amend Bylaw 18733, City of Edmonton Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, CRL Project — Planning and Design, Amendment #3 and under Bylaw 20740 to amend Revised Bylaw 18985, City of Edmonton Community Revitalization Levy Projects, Downtown CRL, Amendment #7, to decrease the borrowing authority, will be presented to City Council for three readings as well.

Bylaw 20737 received first reading at the February 12, 2024, City Council meeting. The petition period expired on Monday, March 11, 2024. No petitions were received, so this Bylaw may proceed.

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Community Insight

Borrowing bylaws reflect a legislative requirement of the borrowing process. As a result, no community insight is undertaken with respect to the borrowing bylaw process. Where required by the *Municipal Government Act*, borrowing bylaws are advertised.
