Bylaw 17677

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw 14010, as amended, being the Southeast Area Structure Plan through an amendment to the Walker Neighbourhood Structure Plan

WHEREAS pursuant to the authority granted to it by the <u>Municipal Government Act</u>, the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton passed Bylaw 14010, as amended, being the Southeast Area Structure Plan on June 30, 2005; and

WHEREAS Council found it desirable to amend Bylaw 14010, as amended, being the Southeast Area Structure Plan by adding a new neighbourhood; and

WHEREAS Council found it desirable to amend the Southeast Area Structure Plan through an amendment to the Walker Neighbourhood Structure Plan;

WHEREAS on April 2, 2007, Council adopted as part of the Southeast Area Structure Plan, Bylaw 14543, the Walker Neighbourhood Structure Plan; and

WHEREAS Council found it desirable to amend Bylaw 14543, through the passage of Bylaws 16199, 16251 and 16931; and

WHEREAS an application was received by Sustainable Development to further amend the Walker Neighbourhood Structure Plan; and

NOW THEREFORE after due compliance with the relevant provisions of the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, ch. M-26, as amended, the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw 14543, the Walker Neighbourhood Structure Plan is hereby amended by:

- a. deleting the entire paragraph of Section 4.3.2 Land Use Concept under heading Wetlands/Natural Areas and replacing it with: "Natural Area SE 16 has been reviewed by Alberta Environment and Parks who has determined that the wetland is not subject to claim under the Public Lands Act. The wetland located at Natural Area 16 shall be designed as a constructed wetland."
- b. deleting the fifth and sixth paragraph of Section 4.4 Stormwater Management Facilities (SWMF) and replacing it with: "The fifth SWMF is located in the very southeast corner of the NSP in place of Natural Area SE 16. The SWMF shall be developed as a constructed wetland in accordance with the City standards at time of development. Design elements that shall be incorporated into the constructed wetland SWMF include, but are not limited to; distinct wetland habitat zones (i.e. deep marsh, shallow marsh, low prairie zone, upland vegetation), use of primarily native vegetation species, transition zone from wetland to upland, and a non-linear shape. Specific design elements will be determined through consultation with Drainage Services and Parks & Biodiversity at detailed engineering design."
- adding a new paragraph under heading Low Density Residential (LDR) of Section
 4.1.2 Land Use Concept prior to the Bylaw 1699 amendment, which reads:
 - "Development of land designated for low density residential may be implemented through standard Zones or a Direct Development Control Provision to achieve unique housing forms, which achieve the Development Objectives"
- d. delete the second paragraph of Section 7.2 Rezoning & Subdivision.
- e. deleting the statistics entitled the "Walker Neighbourhood Structure Plan Land Use and Population Statistics Bylaw 16931" and substituting the following:










