

Reviewing Council's direction

There are three motions for Administration to address:

1. Operating Budget Amendment 12

- Made at the November 30, December 1/2/7/9/12/13/14/15 and 16, 2022 meeting of City Council
- Remove \$15 million from the base operating budget for 2023 2026 (total of \$60 million) and identify \$240 million of options to support affordable housing, public transit, climate change and core services

2. \$10,000,000 for Spring Supplemental Operating Budget Adjustment

- Made at November 21/22/27/28/29, 2023 meeting of City Council
- Bring forward \$10 million of the \$240 million for reallocation or reduction for the tax levy as part of the Spring Supplemental Operating Budget Adjustment

3. Subsequent motion 18 from the Fall 2023 SOBA

 That Administration as part of its regular OP12 updates, include information on Program, Budget and Service Delivery and Planning with the intent to provide insight to improve the budget process ahead of the Fall 2024 Supplemental Operating and Capital Budget Adjustments

OP12 Decision

- Council may chose omnibus option or individual items
- Direction is required to:
 - be incorporated into the Spring SOBA (to either lower the tax levy or provide options for re-allocation for 2024)
 - Return to the Fall SOBA to implement for future years

SOBA Decision

- Council sets final tax levy requirement
- Risks:
 - SOBA is one day
 - Debating reductions & additions are time consuming
 - Tax Bylaws are firm the following week

 Finalizes mill rate for 2024

Fall SOBA

 Adjustments for 2025 and 2026



Items excluded from Omnibus Option

- Items not desired based on Council discussion, or not easily implemented
 - Examples: Eliminate Edmonton Heritage Council and Sports Council annual funding
- Items that have zero dollar impacts in 2024, including TBD
 - May be considered for future SOBAs
- Revenue items
 - Risk to allocate budget until revenues are realized
 - Fines influence behavior and therefore not sustainable
 - Examples: Increase fees for commemorative programs, invest in parking enforcement to drive increased revenues
- Items that can be actioned alongside others

Note: all items removed from omnibus option remain available for individual selection


