Attachment 1

Guiding Objectives

Assessment of EWS' proposed rates shall reflect the following objectives:

- (i) EWS is entitled to a reasonable margin of profit from operations in relation to the provision of utility services within the boundaries of the city of Edmonton;
- (ii) The citizens of the city of Edmonton must be provided with safe and reliable utility services;
- (iii) All customer charges will be based upon cost of service;
- (iv) Rates will be sufficient to ensure the continued development of utility infrastructure to reasonably ensure the satisfaction of these objectives;
- (v) Utility services are to be provided in a manner that reflects reasonable environmental management and aligns with City objectives;
- (vi) Service levels and EWS performance will be assessed with reference to industry benchmarks and/or EWS' historical performance;
- (vii) PBR hearing process will provide EWS with an opportunity to present its final argument and/or summarize its position before a decision on rates is rendered; and,
- (viii) The timing of a decision and the effective date for approved rates must reflect the financial needs of EWS.
