### 1 5.60 Landscaping

3.1 Trees and shrubs for <u>Single Detached Housing</u>, <u>Duplex Housing</u>, <u>Semi-detached Housing</u>, and <u>Row Housing</u>, excluding <u>Cluster Housing</u> developments, must comply with Table 3.1

3.1.1.	Where the <u>Site Width</u> is less than <u>8.0 m</u>	1-2 trees and 4 shrubs

3.1.3.	Where the <u>Site Width</u> is greater than <u>15.0 m</u>	4 trees and 8 shrubs

3.1.4.	Per principal <u>Dwelling</u>	1 tree and 4 shrubs

Proposed amendment in response to require more trees for Single Detached Housing, Duplex Housing, Semi-detached Housing and Row Housing, excluding Cluster Housing developments, where the Site Width is less than 8.0 m.

Currently, 1 tree is required where the Site Width is less than 8.0 m.
