#### **Council Motion**

That Administration prepare amendments to subsection 3.1.1 of section 5.6 of Charter Bylaw 20001 by deleting:

+ "Where the Site Width is less than 8.0 metres - 1 tree and 4 shrubs"

And replacing it with:

+ "Where the Site Width is less than 8.0 metres - 2 trees and 4 shrubs"




## **Minimum Tree Requirements**

#### **CHARTER BYLAW 20001**

+ 5.60 Landscaping

Where the Site Width is less than 8.0 m, the minimum tree and shrub requirements is 1 tree and 4 shrubs

- + Rationale for changes include:
  - Low compliance
  - Spatial constraints
  - Flexibility for private amenity space



## **Modelling for Minimum Tree Requirements**

### (RS) Small Scale Residential Zone


- + Single Detached House with Rear Detached Garage (left)
- + Single Detached House with a Front Attached Garage (right)
- + No treed boulevard




## **Modelling for Minimum Tree Requirements**

## (RSF) Small Scale Flex Residential Zone

- + Single Detached House with a Rear Attached Garage (left)
- + Single Detached House with a Front Attached Garage (middle)
- + Single Detached House with a Rear Detached Garage (right)
- No treed boulevard







#### Recommendation

#### **Non-Support**

- It is the position of Administration that the proposed amendment would not achieve its intended outcome
- + Where the Site Width is less than 8.0 metres 1 tree and 4 shrubs is the recommended to remain the minimum requirement
