Waste Services Rate Filings

- → Utility rates are used to fund the cost of providing waste services
- → Rate filings set the necessary rates
- → Two-year rate filing (2023 and 2024) approved in 2022
- → 0.9% rate increases in both 2023 and 2024 were projected based on customer growth and three-stream apartment and condo collection





2023 Financials

- → Positive variances in both operating and capital budgets
 - → Operational efficiencies, contract savings, higher interest income, project delays
- → No operational impact to Waste Services or ratepayers
- Available cash has been used to manage the impact of debt to the City and keep utility rates stable and consistent



Annual Rate Filings - 2025 and 2026

- → Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) takes effect in Alberta April 1, 2025
- → Ongoing EPR contract negotiations will have a financial impact
- → Multi-year rate filings will be considered in upcoming years to align with the four-year City budgeting process
