City Policy C558B - Waste Services Fiscal Policy

- → Fiscal policy guides the financial operations of Waste Services to balance effective service and cost to ratepayers
- → Two core principles to the fiscal policy:
 - Waste is financially sustainable and self-funded
 - Waste has a consistent year-over-year approach to financial budgeting and planning



Overview Of Proposed Changes

- → Debt Management
 - → Debt Service Coverage Ratio (target of 1.5)
 - → Debt to Net Assets Ratio (target between 50% to 70%)
- → Stable Consistent Rate Increases
 - Removal of requirement to keep rate increases to within two per cent of the Consumer Price Index (CPI)
 - Restricted Waste Services to be able to minimize rate increases if not needed



Recommendation

- → That Utility Committee recommend to City Council:
 - → That revised Waste Services Fiscal Policy C558C, as set out in Attachment 1 of the June 24, 2024, City Operations report CO02410, be approved.
- Updated fiscal policy supports Administration in advance of next rate filing
