CHARTER BYLAW 20850

To allow for smaller scale parks and amenities, Queen Mary Park, Westmount, Prince Rupert, and Inglewood

Purpose

Rezoning the portion of road closed by Bylaw 20849 from DC2.1070, BE, IM, and MU h16.0 f3.5 cf to PSN.

Readings

Charter Bylaw 20850 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree that Charter Bylaw 20850 be considered for third reading.
