City Plan and Growth Management


The City Plan

Outcome: Edmonton's growth and development mutually benefit the city and region


Intention: Growth is managed with regard to long term fiscal impacts and full lifecycle costs of infrastructure and services

Direction: Require substantial completion of the developing area including service provision, amenities and infrastructure prior to authorizing preparation of statutory plans for the contiguous development of the future growth area

Phasing and activating growth are growth management tools

Preparations for Council Authorization

Terms of Reference Update

Incorporate climate lens and updated IIMP approach

Integrated Infrastructure Management Plan (IIMP) Renewal

- Neighbourhood designs and City influences that yield better long term fiscal outcomes
- Link outcomes of IIMPs to City budget planning
- Consideration for large redevelopments

Infrastructure Servicing Study

- Establish understanding of infrastructure serviceability
- Support optimal servicing sizing in adjacent developing areas
- Identify major water, drainage and transportation networks, and natural assets

Next Steps for Substantial Completion

ADMINISTRATION

Substantial completion will be formalized in an administrative standard shared with Council via memo by Q4 2024

Annual monitoring and public reporting on status of metrics

Advance high level servicing study scope to identify future growth area development opportunities and constraints

FUTURE COUNCIL DECISIONS

When the threshold is met for each required metric, Council will receive Administration's recommendation to authorize statutory planning in the future growth area
