

Bylaw 17596

Closure of portions of lanes north of 110 Avenue NW and east of 113 Street NW, Queen Mary Park

Purpose

To close portions of lanes north of 110 Avenue NW and east of 113 Street NW.

Readings

Bylaw 17596 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 17596 be considered for third reading."

Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw has been advertised in the Edmonton Journal on Friday, March 18, 2016, and Saturday, March 26, 2016. The Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

Report

Bylaw 17596 proposes to close portions of lanes north of 110 Avenue NW and east of 113 Street NW in the Queen Mary Park neighbourhood. Once closed, the land would be consolidated with surrounding land and be subject to the (AP) Public Parks Zone.

This Bylaw is accompanied by an associated proposed amendment to the Central McDougall/Queen Mary Park Area Redevelopment Plan (Bylaw 17597) and proposed rezoning (Bylaw 17598).

Comments from other civic departments and utility agencies have been addressed.
