To allow a change in area of application for (DC1) Direct Development Control Provisions (Area 1 and 5), Oliver

Purpose

Rezoning from DC1 to DC1, located south of 103 Avenue between 111 Street NW and the lane west of 123 Street NW.

Readings

Bylaw 17603 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 17603 be considered for third reading."

Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw has been advertised in the Edmonton Journal on Friday, March 18, 2016, and Saturday, March 26, 2016. The Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

Report

Bylaw 17603 to amend the Zoning Bylaw from (DC1) Direct Development Control Provision to (DC1) Direct Development Control Provision is required to facilitate the alignment of land use policy with the 104 Avenue Corridor Area Redevelopment Plan policy through the associated Zoning Bylaw amendment (Bylaw 17595). Associated amendments to the the Oliver Area Redevelopment Plan (Bylaw 17594) and the 104 Avenue Corridor Area Redevelopment Plan (Bylaw 17593) are proceeding concurrently with this Bylaw.
