**BYLAW 17559**

**CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF 153 AVENUE NW ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY, FRASER**

Whereas, pursuant to section 22 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, a council of a municipality may by bylaw close a road within the municipality; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 22 and 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*, a bylaw closing a road must be advertised; and

Whereas, pursuant to section 22 of the *Municipal Government Act*, before a bylaw closing a road is passed, a person who claims to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw, or that person's agent must be given an opportunity to be heard by the council; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 63 and 66 of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may by bylaw authorize the revision of all or any of the bylaws of a municipality, and any of the provisions of the revised bylaws are substituted for the previous bylaws, when they have the same effect, operate retrospectively as well as prospectively and are deemed to come into force on the days on which the corresponding previous bylaws came into force;


Edmonton City Council enacts:

**PART I - PURPOSE, DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION**

- PURPOSE**                    1            The purpose of this bylaw is to close a portion of road as set out in Schedule “A” to this bylaw.
- DEFINITIONS**                2            In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:
- (a)        “**City**” means the municipal corporation of the City of Edmonton;
  - (b)        “**Council**” means the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton; and
  - (c)        “**Registrar**” means the Registrar of Titles as defined by the *Land Titles Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. L-4.
