Background and Context





- DATS provides door-to-door shared ride public transportation service for those who are unable to use conventional transit service
- Service targets to ensure availability and reliability of service: 98% trip accommodation rate and 90% on-time performance
- Several improvements since launch of multi-year plan to improve DATS in 2019
- Additional opportunities to further enhance rider experience

Options To Improve The DATS Rider Experience



1. Expand service hours

- Accommodate more early morning and late night trips
- Provide subsidized taxi service for trips outside of DATS service hours



2. Provide more spontaneous transportation options on the day of service

- Increase availability of same-day trip bookings
- > Support increased flexibility and reduced trip cancellations & no shows



3. Shorten the DATS pick-up window

- Change from 30-minute pick-up window to 20-minute pick-up window
- > Support reduced overall trip times

Ongoing Enhancements

- Upgrades to the online booking platform
- New feature to allow riders to book trips based on appointment times
- System integration with taxi dispatch software will:
 - **a.** Increase DATS service flexibility
 - **b.** Provide automated platform for subsidized taxi program
 - **c.** Enable oversight of availability and wait times for private accessible taxis
