July 15, 2024	<b>Deadline for Written Questions</b> to EWS from Councillors, Utility Advisor and Administration.
July 22, 2024	<b>Deadline for Public Submissions</b> to receive a written response from EWS. Public submissions received after this date will be received for information only.
August 5, 2024	<b>EWS Written Responses</b> to questions from Councillors, Utility Advisor, Administration and Public Submissions.
September 4, 2024	<b>Reasonableness Report from Administration</b> on review of rates applications (external consultant engaged to assist, if required).
September 4, 2024	<b>Report from the Utility Advisor</b> on review of rates applications.
October 4, 2024	<b>EWS' Response to Reports of Reasonableness</b> from Administration and Utility Advisor.
October 11, 2024	<b>Utility Committee Meeting</b> - to review rates applications and submissions from EWS, Administration, Utility Advisor, and public. Recommendation to City Council regarding approval of rates applications and applicable bylaws.
November 12, 2024	<b>Amended Rates Applications</b> - EWS amends applications and applicable bylaws (if required based on directions from Utility Committee).
Between November 13, 2024 and January 17, 2025	<b>City Council Meeting</b> - approval of rates applications and three readings of applicable bylaws.

#### Attachment 4

### **Guiding Objectives**

Assessment of EWS' proposed rates shall reflect the following objectives:

- (i) EWS is entitled to a reasonable margin of profit from operations in relation to the provision of utility services within the boundaries of the city of Edmonton;
- (ii) The citizens of the city of Edmonton must be provided with safe and reliable utility services;
- (iii) All customer charges will be based upon cost of service;
- (iv) Rates will be sufficient to ensure the continued development of utility infrastructure to reasonably ensure the satisfaction of these objectives;
- (v) Utility services are to be provided in a manner that reflects reasonable environmental management and aligns with City objectives;
- (vi) Service levels and EWS performance will be assessed with reference to industry benchmarks and/or EWS' historical performance;
- (vii) PBR hearing process will provide EWS with an opportunity to present its final argument and/or summarize its position before a decision on rates is rendered; and,
- (viii) The timing of a decision and the effective date for approved rates must reflect the financial needs of EWS.
