- Edmonton needs to make its existing places more productive (lower liabilities and higher property value) long term.

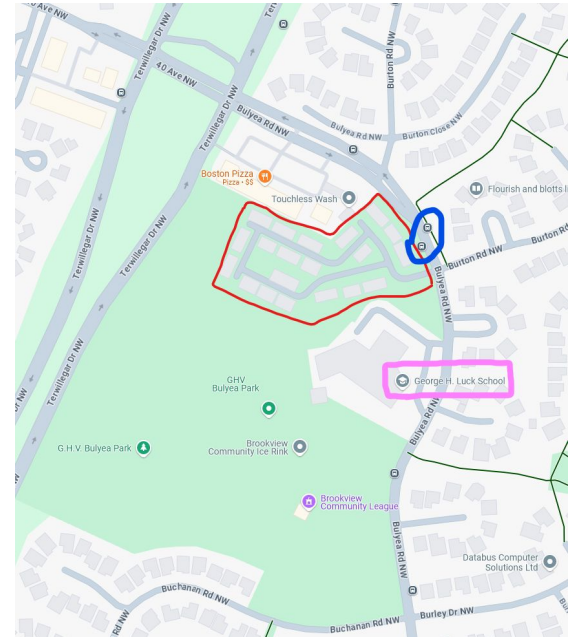
Two Major Arguments
