Based on the compressed timelines related to these staffing increases, the project needed to advance on an urgent timeline. Three quotes were obtained for this project, and it was awarded to A.S.A.P. Contracting Services Ltd, who was also awarded the initial demolition portion of the contract. The contract award was required to improve the construction schedule and return EDGE and GST to full operational effectiveness as soon as possible.

To ensure fairness and transparency, EPS conducted an Advanced Contract Award Notice (ACAN) that was issued on the Alberta Purchasing Connection, signaling the intent to award a sole-source contract to Villeneuve Aviation Centre (VAC) Inc. EPS received no responses from other vendors and awarded the aviation fuel contract to the vendor. The Edmonton Police Commission approved the ACAN on March 9th, 2023. This has benefited EPS by resulting in a formal contract with Villeneuve Aviation Centre rather than the previous month to month arrangement. The vendor provides a discount on aviation fuel to the EPS, which equates to

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					approximately \$20,000 - \$30,000 annually.

Additionally, all components that require factory service or overhaul maintenance must be shipped to Airbus as they are the only authorized service center. The EPS cannot use third party manufacturers for parts, service, or overhaul requirements; therefore, Airbus Helicopters is the only supplier available to the EPS.

The EPS conducted a proof of concept (POC) and began working with Axon. After the EPS had completed its POC, the Government of Alberta (GOA) announced that it will conduct a competitive procurement that will be accessible to all municipal agencies. To bridge the gap between the present and the availability of a GOA contract, the EPS entered into a contract with Axon.
