



## MOTIONS PENDING REPORT

### 10.1 Downtown Investment Plan (A. Stevenson)

Councillor A. Stevenson stated that at the next regular meeting of City Council, the following motion would be moved:

That Administration review the Downtown Investment Plan presented by downtown stakeholders and:

1. provide an analysis of the report,
  2. compile investments the City has made in the downtown and their impacts to date,
  3. itemize what additional funding is committed in the downtown, and
  4. identify opportunities to leverage existing funding programs, including infill infrastructure funding and others, that could help accelerate investment in the downtown.

### 10.2 Amendments to Bylaw 18156 Council Committees Bylaw - Creation of Infrastructure Standing Committee (M. Janz)

That Administration prepare amendments to the Council Committee Bylaw to create an Infrastructure Standing Committee with the membership comprised of four members of Council. The Committee, once established and a work plan is set, may also add external stakeholders.

#### **10.4 Sale of Land - Wellington Park (E. Rutherford)**

Councillor E. Rutherford stated that at the next regular meeting of City Council, the following motion would be moved:

That Administration provide a report that includes:

- a. Identification of any portion of Plan 2488KS, Block 76, Lot 1 (Wellington Park in the Athlone Neighbourhood) that may be surplus to municipal requirements.
  - b. The implications (financial or otherwise) of the potential sale of any identified surplus land at nominal (\$1.00) value to the Council for the Advancement of African Canadians in Alberta for the purposes of building a cultural hub.
  - c. A draft term sheet for the potential nominal (\$1.00) value sale of any identified surplus land to the Council for the Advancement of African Canadians in Alberta wherein all planning, development / site and construction costs would be the responsibility of the Council for the Advancement of African Canadians in Alberta.

#### **10.5 Economic Development (A. Sohi)**

- a jurisdictional scan of economic development approaches, governance and funding models in other similar North American cities and/or city regions,
  - the roles, mandate, budget, and outcomes of Edmonton Global, Edmonton Screen Industries Office, Edmonton Unlimited and Explore Edmonton,
  - current support provided by each agency to Edmonton's local economy,
  - governance considerations for each agency, and
  - recommendations for opportunities to collectively improve efficiencies, outcomes and support for the local economy.
