COUNCIL REPORT -LAND USE PLANNING BYLAW

BYLAW 21005

To amend the Rosenthal Neighbourhood Structure Plan

Purpose

To reconfigure land uses to increase the amount of land designated commercial and reduce the amount of land designated as residential and public utility.

Previous Council/Committee Action

At the December 9, 2024 City Council Public Hearing, the following motion was passed:

"That Bylaws 21004, 21005 and 21006 be referred back to Administration to add a District Plan Amendment and return to the January 24, 2025, City Council Public Hearing."

Readings

Bylaw 21005 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree that Bylaw 21005 be considered for third reading.

Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw was advertised in the Edmonton Journal on January 11, 2025, and January 15, 2025. The Bylaw can be passed following third reading.
