


# **Emergency Operations Centre Activations**

Activation	Dates Activated	People Impacted	
Encampment Response	January 17 to September 3	5,124 visitors (2,957 unique), and residents, businesses and visitors near encampment sites	
Corporate contingency planning	March 11 to 15	4,400 CSU members and Edmontonians impacted by service disruptions	
NHL Playoffs	May 1 to June 24	Up to 35,000 fans per game	
Rural Municipality of Wood Buffalo Wildfires	May 14 to 19	1,845 evacuees registered in Edmonton	
Canada Day	July 1	~36,000 people attended	
Jasper Wildfires	July 23 to September 3	2,826 evacuees registered in Edmonton	
Apartment Evacuation	December 23	More than 50 people	
New Year's Eve	December 31	~20,000 people attended
