Community and Public Services	 Operational Delivery of City Services Neighbourhoods and communities; social development; recreational activities and facilities; cultural and social programs and activities; emergency services; and municipal enforcement.
Urban Planning	 Sustainable City Planning Growth, development and management of the urban form; urban transportation; infrastructure; parks; municipal reserve; environmental, housing and real estate planning; and community engagement for urban planning matters.
Infrastructure	Development, Delivery, Renewal, and Decommissioning of City Infrastructure • Cost, schedule and scope of capital projects; capital project development, and delivery.
