
## **Christmas Tree Collection**

- Available to residents with curbside collection only.
- Not a core service and budgeted as planned overtime.
- → Drop-off at Recycling Depots and Eco Stations available immediately after Christmas.



Fewer Edmontonians are setting out Christmas trees, and Administration supports ending Christmas tree collection in favour of a drop-off depot model.

# **Christmas Tree Disposal Options**

- → Edmontonians will be encouraged to drop off trees at Community Recycling Depots or Eco Stations. This service change will start being communicated by the end of 2025.
- → Trees can be cut up and disposed of through multiple methods:
  - $\rightarrow$  Small twigs (no wider than 2.5 cm diameter) can go in food scraps cart
  - $\rightarrow$  Larger branches and tree trunks should be taken to an Eco Station
  - $\rightarrow$  Use as mulch, home composting material or around the yard








### **Key Takeaways**

→ Moving to a depot drop-off model for Christmas trees:

- $\rightarrow$  Supports equity between collection services
- $\rightarrow$  Reduces extra labour costs and fuel consumption
- → Does not impact majority of residents with curbside collection
