BYLAW 21146 - EDMONTON SALUTES COMMITTEE BYLAW AMENDMENT

Recommendation

That Bylaw 21146 be given the appropriate readings.

Purpose

To amend Bylaw 19018 - Edmonton Salutes Committee Bylaw, to include a maximum term limit of eight consecutive years for all members.

Readings

This bylaw is ready for three readings.

REPORT

Bylaw 18156 - Council Committees Bylaw provides a maximum term limit for members of Council Committees of eight consecutive years, unless otherwise directed by Council. The bylaw also states that if there is a conflict with a bylaw establishing a Council Committee, the establishing bylaw prevails.

Bylaw 19018 - Edmonton Salutes Committee Bylaw, currently allows for members to be appointed for up to two-year terms, and re-appointed at the discretion of the entity making the appointment without a maximum number of terms. This proposed Bylaw 21146 adds a maximum term length of eight consecutive years for all members of Edmonton Salutes Committee, which aligns with the Council Committees Bylaw and the practices applicable to other Council Committees.

Community Insight

This bylaw amendment proposes changes to Council's governance practices; public engagement regarding the change was not conducted.
