# COMMUNITY AND PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT Regional Plan of Action to Address Housing and Homelessness, Mental Health and Addictions

### Recommendation of the Committee

That the Mayor, on behalf of City Council, request a meeting with the appropriate provincial ministries and the regional municipalities to review the March 31, 2025, Community Services report CS02575 and to get a more detailed understanding of the recovery model they are working on, the regional plan of action to address housing and homelessness, mental health and addictions, and how the City can better align its limited funding to achieve the best outcomes possible.

At the March 31, 2025, Community and Public Services Committee meeting, the March 31, 2025, Community Services report CS02575 - Transition Strategy for Homelessness Related Services was considered.

- Integrate the findings from the regional housing needs assessment including the services available in municipalities surrounding Edmonton and their approach for supporting people experiencing homelessness, mental health and addictions in their municipalities.
- 3. An itemized list of supports and services requested of the Province to meet Edmonton's needs in housing, people experiencing homelessness, and homelessness and mental health or addictions in Edmonton.
