# Historic Resources: Register and Inventory

The City works with the [Edmonton Historical Board](#) to review nominations and amendments to the Inventory of Historic Resources in Edmonton. Existing zoning, development rights and regulations still apply to properties on the Inventory.

## catalogued and designated by the city and province

The main difference between the Register and Inventory is the degree of protection provided.

**The Inventory** is a list of heritage resources that merit conservation, but are not legally protected. Once they are designated as a Municipal Historic Resource they are put on the Register and protected.
