**RESERVE DESIGNATION BYLAW  
(CARLISLE)**

Whereas, pursuant to section 665(1) of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass bylaws designating parcels of land it owns as Municipal Reserve, School Reserve or Municipal and School reserve:

1. This bylaw designates certain lands owned by the City of Edmonton as Municipal Reserve.

2. Council hereby requires that the following parcels generally shown on Schedule A be designated as Municipal Reserve by the Registrar of Alberta Land Titles:

3. The Registrar shall do all things necessary to give effect to this bylaw, including cancelling the existing Certificate of Title and

issuing a new Certificate of Title with the designation of Municipal Reserve, which shall be identified by a number suffixed by the letters “MR”.
