- Financial impacts and funding agreement discussed





Findings

Standardized Maintenance Model Challenges

- Extended hours
- Rapid service turnaround
- Event-specific infrastructure
- Building systems incompatible with corporate systems (CCURE)

Taking on Maintenance Responsibilities

- Liability
- Complexity
- Expanded shift coverage, overtime and additional resources

City Oversight

- Significant administrative overhead
- Contract management



Next Steps





- Shared contract use
- Third-party review of maintenance plans
- Addressing inflationary pressures

- Aligning maintenance standards
- Reporting expectations
- Lifecycle planning



Budget and Financial Implications

- The City's current operating budget cannot accommodate absorbing maintenance responsibilities for Explore Edmonton without impacting service levels at other City facilities.
- Transferring costs, in addition to the existing operating grant, would require new funding beyond what is currently approved.
