THE CITY OF EDMONTON BYLAW 21284 COUNCIL DISCLOSURE BYLAW Amendment No. 1

Edmonton City Council enacts:

- 1. Bylaw 20901, Council Disclosure Bylaw, is amended by this bylaw.
- 2. Section 2(2)(b) is amended by deleting "and".
- 3. Section 2(2)(c) is amended by inserting "and" following "chief elected official".
- 4. Section 2(2)(d) is added following section 2(2)(c):
 - (d) "gift" means
 - (i) an amount of money if there is no obligation to repay it; or
 - (ii) a service or property, or the use of property or money that is provided without charge or at less than its commercial value

that is accepted by a Councillor, or a member of the Councillor's family or an employee, volunteer, or contractor on behalf of a Councillor, and may reasonably be seen to have been given to influence the Councillor in the exercise of an official power, duty, or function or is received as a normal expression of courtesy or protocol.

5. The title of Part II - Statement of Disclosure is deleted and replaced with:

PART II - STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE

6. Sections 6.1, 6.2, and 6.3, including the title of Part II.A, are added following section 6:

PART II.A - DISCLOSURE OF GIFTS

DISCLOSURE OF GIFTS

6.1 (1) No later than 4:30 p.m. on the last business day of January, April, July, and October each year, every Councillor must file a statement of disclosure with the City Manager that includes:

- (a) a list of all single gifts with a fair market value of \$300 or more received in the three months prior to the month the statement of disclosure is submitted;
- (b) a list of all gifts from a single donor with a cumulative total fair market value of \$300 or more received in the calendar year to which the statement of disclosure relates;
- (c) the fair market value of each gift;
- (d) a description of each gift;
- (e) the date and/or occasion on which each gift was received; and
- (f) the name of the person providing each gift.
- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to:
 - (a) gifts of tangible items received by a Councillor on behalf of the City and provided to the City Manager; or
 - (b) gifts authorized by an enactment.

PUBLICATION

No later than 30 days following the submission of statements of disclosure required by section 6.1, the City Manager must publish the information disclosed by all Councillors, except the names of the Councillors' family and other personal information, on the City's website.

RETENTION	6.3	The City Manager must retain the statements of disclosure required to be filed by section 6.1 in accordance with the applicable City records retention schedule approved pursuant to the City Administration Bylaw, Bylaw 16620.
