That a new Council Initiative named "Gender Based Violence and Sexual Exploitation Prevention", be established with Councillors B. Esslinger and A. Sohi appointed as delegates, and Administration prepare Terms of Reference for Council's approval.

# Report

  projects that City Council deems would benefit from having a Member of City
  Council as a sponsor.
- Under authority outlined in Council Initiative Policy C518, Council directed Administration to prepare Terms of Reference for the initiatives identified at the December 11, 2013, City Council meeting in collaboration with sponsor Councillors.
- The Terms of Reference for the Gender Based Violence Prevention Initiative, approved by the sponsor Councillors, is contained in Attachment 1.
- During development of the Terms of Reference, there was agreement that the name and scope of the initiative would be limited to Gender Based Violence Prevention.
