

Charter Bylaw 21428

A Charter Bylaw to amend Charter Bylaw 24003,
being the Ellerslie District Plan

WHEREAS pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Municipal Government Act, as amended by the *City of Edmonton Charter, 2018 Regulation, AR 39/2018*, on October 2, 2024, the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton passed Charter Bylaw 24003, being the Ellerslie District Plan; and

WHEREAS Council found it desirable from time to time to amend the Ellerslie District Plan;
and

WHEREAS an application was received by Administration to amend the Ellerslie District Plan;

NOW THEREFORE after due compliance with the relevant provisions of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c. M-26, as amended, and as amended by the City of Edmonton Charter, 2018 Regulation, AR 39/2018, the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. That Charter Bylaw 24003, being the Ellerslie District Plan, is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. Deleting the map “Map 1: Heritage and Culture” and replacing it with the map “Map 1: Heritage and Culture”, attached hereto as Schedule “A”, and forming part of this charter bylaw;

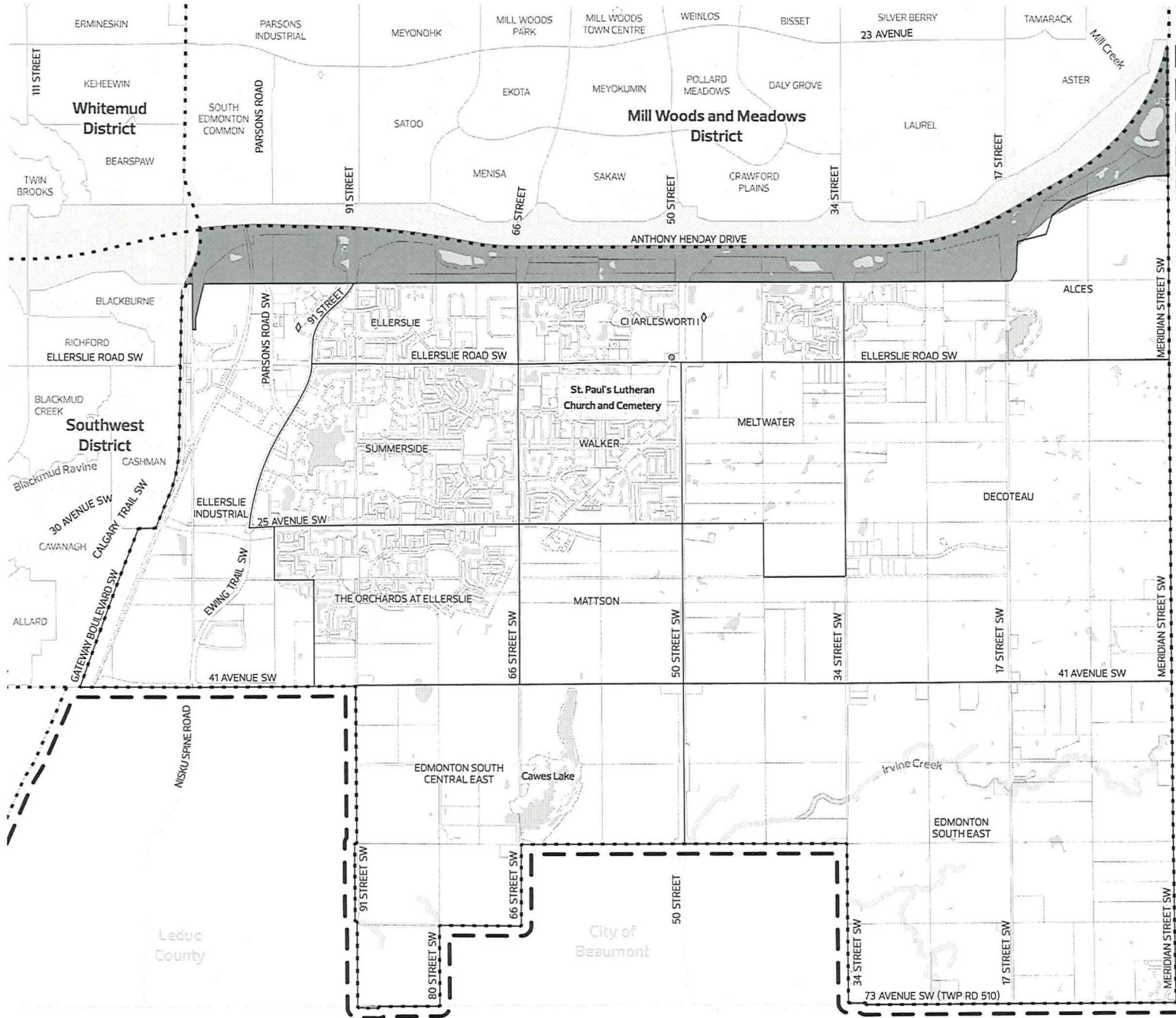
